Website Revisions (dosafl.com)

Overall Styling & Design

• The "blocky" nature of various sections of the website are simply too wide, which likely has to do with all the oversized blocks, which includes images, thumbnails, buttons, etc.

Navigation

- Change menu style from a MENU button to a visible menu structure as seen here: http://dosanew.flywheelsites.com
- This navigation style must reflect across all subdomain sites as well.
- For each subdomain site menu, include a link above main menu (include a top menu) that says "Return to homepage" next to the Search icon that redirects visitors back to diocesan homepage (dosafl.com) as seen in this mockup (page 4): https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6
- The new visible menu layout would require a dropdown menu for any nested links. An example of a similar header menu would be the Diocese of St. Petersburg: www.dosp.org

Fonts

- Change Header/Title fonts from Verlag > PT Sans and Body text font from Verlag > EB Garamond.
- For captions and photo credits use PT Sans.
- Decrease fonts sizes across the board. One complaint from our survey was that the font sizes were too large. We may need to test this.
- Would also like to have use of font called "Daily Planet" to give some sections a little creative flare, as seen in the Go Make Disciples Newsletter sign-up section in this website mockup: http://dosanew.flywheelsites.com/. Download font here: https://www.dafont.com/daily-planet.font

Print Feature

- Need to investigate a better way to showcase pages as printer-friendly. The current look is not acceptable to KB. Is there a way to only show article headline and body copy only? No other elements, just copy in a readable format, plain and simple.
- Is it possible to auto-generate a printer-friendly text version of every current and new page that gets created?

Homepage

- Diocesan Initiatives Block Section. On page 1 of mock-up (https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6). Currently we are using the Stackable plugin to create this section, however, the available styling options are not what we would like. Is there a way to create a custom block that could be styled according to our liking? Example would be the "Our Spotlight" and "Daily Reflection" boxes on the homepage of the USCCB website (just under main header).
- *Video background*. Change video background to a rotating banner/news section. Would like the option of being able to use this space to showcase featured news stories with anchor image, headline, article excerpt, and an editable "Read More" button.
 - o In instances where we don't have any featured stories we would like this section to act simply as a rotating banner of catchy photos that we can upload from around the diocese.

- Newsletter signup section. Would like to give Go Make Disciples diocesan newsletter signup form a little more styling, similar to what you see in this website mockup: http://dosanew.flywheelsites.com/, while showcasing social media icons as seen in this mockup: https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6.
 - For subdomain sites that have their own ministry newsletter sign-up, make the title for the section editable so they can add their own title. Keep integration with MailChimp features the same.
- News Briefs section. Looking for an alternative style to the Diocesan (Latest) News section from the current block format to a more vertically linear flow with left thumbnail, headline, author/date metadata, and article excerpt as seen in this mockup (page 1) https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6
 - o And, of course, include a "More News" button at bottom to redirect to the diocesan news archive page.
 - o Would like if we could also make the RSS feed from Catholic News Service appear the same way, next to the diocesan news feed. See mockup (page 1): https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6
- *Header Logo*. Make it so that no matter whether visitor is on main diocesan site or a subdomain site, when they click the diocesan logo in the top-left corner it will redirect to the main diocesan homepage (dosafl.com).

Footer

- Would like to redesign website footer to reflect a design similar to this mockup: https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6
 - We will need to be able to add/remove/edit links as-needed.
 - Remove former designers info "Made by Highland" logo

Internal Pages

- Would like to redesign internal page style to a 30/70 or 40/60 split, with left sidebar menu and content in the right-hand column. See mockup (page 2): https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6. Consult with Diocesan on this?
- Styling of elements on pages are too large (i.e., images, thumbnails, buttons, etc.) creating large sections that require more scrolling than necessary. Example: https://www.dosafl.com/racism/
- Sidebar menu items would include links to other nested menu pages under the same section. you can also find an example at http://dosanew.flywheelsites.com/bishop-felipe-j-estevez/. How would this look across all pages, especially for pages that may not be part of the main navigation hierarchy? Would it be possible to add links manually to sidebars?
- This would need to apply to all subdomain pages as well.

News Posts

- Include Social Share buttons at top and right of article copy followed by "More News" section directly beneath icons, showcasing up to 3-4 recent news articles.
- Would like the ability to wrap text around an image and include a caption with photo as seen on page 3 of mockup: https://bit.ly/2DvC5G6
 - o In addition, would like the ability to add a photo gallery at bottom of a news story.

Additional Features That Need Tweaking

• *Blocks Alignment*. Whether it is text, photo or video, in some instances, there have been some alignment issues. At times when attempting to embed a YouTube video aligned center, the video will remain aligned left on the front-end.
